



Advanced Horsemanship Camp

When: Monday July 8, 2018 to Saturday July 13, 2018. (**overnight**)

Where: Falcon Hill Farm, 785 Paradise Cove Ln Wilsonville, AL 35186

What will we do? Your kids will get the feel of owning a farm and learn all about horses in the process! They will have a riding lesson in the morning followed by educational lectures on horse care/training, course design, and stable management. In the afternoon they will complete barn chores and ride a second time. One night we will go to a movie and out for dinner. Riders will be challenged and quizzed on what they learn each day. Lectures include but are not limited to; basic first aid for horses, feed and nutrition, teeth, vaccinations and diseases, hoof care, course design, show turnout, and horse show etiquette.

What time? Campers arrive at 8:00 am Monday morning and stay the week. Optional participation in our AHJA sanctioned horse show on July 13th.

How much? \$600 for the week or \$125 per day.

Who can come? All riders ages 12 and up jumping at least 2' courses or training level dressage.

What to bring: -Proper riding attire including; breeches/jods, boots, helmet, gloves. (see Carousel Tack Shoppe Flyer below if any of this is needed) - fitted T-shirts, sun shirts, and or polos for riding. Clothes you can get dirty for barn work. One nice casual outfit for movie night. Refillable water bottle. Snacks of choice. Overnight toiletries and sleepwear. Sheets are provided. Please bring a blanket and pillow. Sunscreen and Bug Spray. Show clothes if participating in the show on Saturday.

Release and Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement

This RELEASE and WAIVER of LIABILITY and INDEMNITY AGREEMENT is made and entered into on this _____ day of _____, 20____, by and between Falcon Hill Farm, LLC (hereinafter designated "FHF"), and

_____ (hereinafter designated "Rider"), and if Rider is a minor, Rider's parent or guardian, _____. In return for the use, today and on all future dates, of the property, facilities and services of FHF, the Rider, his heirs, assigns, and legal representatives, hereby expressly agree to the following:

1. It is the responsibility of the Rider to carry full and complete insurance coverage on himself, his personal property and, if applicable, his horse.
2. Rider agrees to assume ANY AND ALL RISKS INVOLVED IN OR ARISING FROM THE RIDER'S USE OF OR PRESENCE UPON FHF 'S PROPERTY AND FACILITIES including, but not limited to, the risks of death, bodily injury, property damage, falls, kicks, bites, collisions with vehicles, horses or stationary objects, fire or explosion, the unavailability of emergency medical care, or the negligence or deliberate act of another person.
3. Rider agrees to hold FHF and all of its successors, assigns, subsidiaries, affiliates, officers, directors, employees, and agents completely harmless and not liable and release them from all liability whatsoever and AGREES NOT TO SUE them on account of or in connection with any claims, causes of action, injuries, damages, cost or expenses arising out of Rider's use of or presence upon FHF property and facilities, including without limitation, those based on death, bodily injury, property damage, including consequential damages, except if the damages are caused by the direct, willful and wanton negligence of FHF.
4. Rider agrees to waive the protection afforded by any statute or law in any jurisdiction whose purpose, substance and/or effect is to provide that a general release shall not extend to claims, material or other- wise, which the person giving the release does not know or suspect to exist at the time of executing the release.
5. Rider agrees to indemnify and defend FHF against, and hold it harmless from, any and all claims, causes of action, damages, judgments, costs or expenses, including attorney's fees, which in any way arise from the Rider's use of or presence upon FHF's property and facilities.
6. Rider agrees to abide by all of FHF rules and regulations.
7. If Rider is using his horse, the horse shall be free from infection, contagious or transmissible disease. FHF reserves the right to refuse horse if not in proper health or is deemed dangerous or undesirable.
8. This contract is non-assignable and non-transferable and is made and entered into in the State of Alabama and shall be enforced and interpreted as broadly and inclusively as Permitted by laws of the State of Alabama. Should any clause herein be in conflict with State Law, then that clause is null and void but the balance of the contract shall continue in full legal force and effect. When FHF and Rider or Rider's parent or guardian if Rider is a minor, sign this contract, it will then be binding on both parties, subject to the above terms and conditions.
